CAMBRIDGE COUNTY COUNCIL NHS LETTER: SWINE FLU INITIATIVE

Cambridge County Council has written to our Parish Council to help provide volunteers who can support the community through the current global swine flu outbreak.

The distribution of antivirals within the community is a key priority and they have made arrangements for a number of Antiviral Collection Centres to be set up to distribute these medicines to those who need them. The antivirals will be collected from the centres by "flu friends" so patients with swine flu do not attend the centres themselves.

Your help and support is needed to help run these centres so they can operate 12 hours a day, 7 days a week. Comprehensive information packs have been prepared and volunteers will be briefed. Reasonable direct costs will be reimbursed.


