The choir – including several members from Great Chishill and surrounding villages - is looking forward to its first performance here since the church was re-ordered, and to introducing local supporters to their BBC award-winning new Musical Director, Andrew O'Brien. Andrew led the choir of Heath Mount School to win BBC Songs of Praise Choir of the Year in 2012, and coached the BBC Radio 2 Chorister of the Year 2013. This concert includes guest choristers from Haileybury School where Andrew now teaches and a performance of Chopin's Ballad No. 1 in G Minor by one of his talented current pupils.

The programme features Stanford's Three Motets, created for the choir of Trinity College, Cambridge in 1905. With Richard Prince's 'Northumbrian Folk Song Suite', 'Scarborough Fair', medieval 'Sumer is icumen in', Pearsall's eight part 'Lay a Garland', 'Over the Rainbow' and more there is something for every taste.
