**Stop Stansted Expansion has written to the parish council with its step-by-step guide responding to BAA's consultation.**

Stop Stansted Expansion is urging all members of the community with an interest in aircraft noise issues to respond to BAA's Noise Action Plan ('NAP') consultation questionnaire by the closing date of 2 October. This will ensure that the views of those who most directly suffer noise impacts from the airport's operations can be fully taken into account.

To help you to respond quickly and easily, a **step-by-step guide sets out Stop Stansted Expansion's noise team's advice on completing the NAP consultation questionnaire**, with an analysis of the consultation which will be helpful to you in formulating your own response. This 5 step guide is too large for

the newsletter's pages, but can be obtained from the editor.

The steps are basically:

1. Obtain the consultation documents and questionnaire
2. Choose how you will complete the questionnaire
3. Understand the rules of the consultation 'game'
4. Fill in the boxes
5. Add your comments

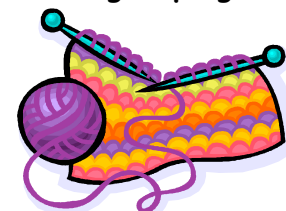
WHERE ARE THOSE
